



## **RULES OF PLAY**

### **Habitat Holiday Raffle 12 Gifts of Christmas**

- What type of raffle is it:
  - prize raffle (12 Draws – 3 Each Hour)
- Who is conducting the raffle (organization):
  - Habitat for Humanity Sarnia/Lambton
- Where is the raffle taking place, date & time of draw:
  - Friday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 1-4 p.m.

- The max number of tickets available and the price of the tickets:
  - Total Tickets Available for Sale 500
  - \$5 ea. Or 5 for \$20
  - Tickets will be sold Monday-Saturday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> to 12 noon on Dec. 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Winning ticket must be presented to claim the prize.
- Winners must agree to allow the use of their name.
- Ticket holders are **not** required to be present to win the draw.
- Winners will be notified using the phone number indicated on the winning ticket.
- Winners will be publicly posted on HFHSL Website, Facebook, Media, displayed on location.
- Purchasers must be over the age of 18 to play.
- Problem Gambling Hotline 1-888-230-3505 must be in all advertisements, posters and on the rules of play and raffle tickets.
- Total prize value of 12 gifts equals \$8,384.00
- Board members, executives, and employees of the organization directly involved with charitable gaming, employees/volunteers of the event location, and prize donors, are **not** eligible to win.
- Tickets will be stored in a locked cash box in a locked office.
- Winning tickets will be drawn from a drum by Habitat for Humanity Staff Member, CEO or President, Donor of Prize or Volunteer
- Should the draw event be cancelled due to a disaster or emergency, the raffle draw will be rescheduled to occur Monday, Dec. 20, 2021
- Contact info for all winners will be shared with the licensing authority.
- Any unclaimed prizes must be held for 6 months from the date of the draw, unless otherwise stated in rules of play. Every reasonable effort to contact the winner will be made; including, attempting to locate the winner using the contact information provided on the ticket, by sending a registered letter if address is available, telephoning the individual, posting on website or Facebook page. Any unclaimed prize will be donated to a charitable organization approved by the group and licensing authority.
