



## **CATCH the ACE RAFFLE RULES of PLAY**

- **RULES and REGULATIONS:**

- Weekly draw to last potentially 52 weeks
- Must be at least 18 years of age to play

- **LOTTERY PROCEEDS:**

- The proceeds from the Catch the Ace raffle will support the Habitat Home Build Program with Habitat for Humanity Sarnia/Lambton (HFHS/L)

- **TICKET SALES:**

- Stub Tickets will be available for purchase daily at the HFHS/L ReStore 9 am – 5 pm Monday to Saturday until the “Ace of Spades” is drawn. Stub Tickets will also be available **Friday, November 26** from 9:30 am – 9:00 pm at the Lambton Mall at 1380 London Rd. Sarnia ON N7S 1P8. Due to the closure of the Habitat offices over the holidays, the weekly draws scheduled for both December 27 and January 3 will be held as one draw on **Tuesday January 4**.
- Tickets will be sold for \$2 each.
- Tickets can be purchased with cash; debit or credit.
- Under no circumstances will unpaid tickets be entered into the draw.
- Tickets are unique for each draw (no duplicate tickets numbers).
- Each purchaser is responsible for checking their purchased ticket at the time of purchase to ensure tickets have been separated and numbers are legible.
- Each purchaser is responsible for providing their personal contact information on the ticket stub and ensure that the information is legible.
- Tickets are only valid for the week they are purchased as printed on the raffle ticket.
- Board members, executives, and employees of the organization directly involved with charitable gaming, employees and volunteers of the event location, are not eligible to purchase tickets.

- **DRAW TIME AND LOCATION:**

- Draws will be conducted on Mondays @ 8:45 am at the HFHS/L ReStore located at 1787 London Line, Sarnia, ON. N7T 7H2 (Draws will be made on Tuesdays following any statutory holidays on Mondays) Please see attached list of draw dates for 52 draws/weeks.
- One ticket, “Winner 1”, will be drawn from a drum by a HFHS/L staff member, CEO or President.
- Only one ticket will be drawn each week until the ACE of Spades is chosen.
- Winning tickets must be presented to claim the prize.
- Winners must agree to allow the use of their name and photo for promotional purposes
- Ticket holders are **not** required to be present to win the weekly or progressive draws.
- Participants will be advised of the Rules of Play and that all raffle draws will be video recorded.
- All draws will be recorded live and will be publicly posted on Website, Facebook, Media, and displayed on location. The video will record the selection of the winning draw ticket, selection of the envelope by the bearer of the winning draw ticket, the envelope number selected and the card contained in the identified envelope.

## **CATCH the ACE RAFFLE RULES of PLAY**

- **DRAW RULES:**

- A standard deck of 52 playing cards will be shuffled face-down, then placed in identical opaque envelopes.
- The sealed envelopes will then be shuffled and randomly numbered from 1 to 52
- The entire procedure will be recorded and retained for 6 months
- Weekly Draw Prizes and Progressive Jackpot amounts will be announced prior to each draw
- Distribution of the Weekly ticket sales revenue will be as follows:
  - 20% to the winning ticket holder
  - 30% will be added to the Progressive Jackpot
  - 50% will go to the HFHS/L Home Build Program
- Weekly on Monday at 8:45 am, 1 ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold from Monday thru Saturday of the week preceding the draw. In case of a Power Outage or other disruptions, the draw will take place the next day at 8:45 am.
- The winner, "Winner 1", if not present at the time of the draw, will be contacted using the contact details provided on their ticket stub. "Winner 1" will be asked to come into the ReStore to claim 20% of the weekly ticket sales, to choose an envelope from the display board, and to open the envelope to reveal the card. Three attempts to contact "Winner 1" will be made until 5 pm the day after the draw.
- If "Winner 1" does not contact HFHS/L by 5pm the day after the draw, "Winner 1" will not receive 20% of the weekly ticket sales or the opportunity to choose an envelope from the display board. A second, "back up", ticket will be drawn and the "Backup Winner" will be contacted using the contact details provided on their ticket stub. The "Backup Winner" will be asked to come into the ReStore to claim the weekly prize of 20% of weekly ticket sales, to choose an envelope from the display board, and to open the envelope to reveal the card.
- If the winner is unable to select an envelope in person, the winner will be contacted via a live video call using Facetime, Zoom or Google Meet, to choose a card. The envelope chosen will be opened live for the winner. If the card is not the ACE of Spades, it will be destroyed. The winner will still receive the 20% weekly prize.
- The maximum prize board to be awarded will be \$50,000.
- Maximum tickets available with this license is a total of 961 allowable weekly.
- The unique ticket sequence used that week of the draw and the winning ticket number(s) of "Winner 1" and "Winner 2" etc. will be entered into the weekly "ticket log". Subsequently, the stubs will be removed from the drum, placed into sealed containers and retained until 30 days after the conclusion of the license.
- Video recordings of the event will be recorded and copies will be secured in a safe place onsite for a minimum of 30 days.
- The video recording is in high definition (minimum resolution – 720p) in a well-lit environment with an unobstructed view of all raffle activities and will show the selection of the envelope# by the bearer of the winning weekly draw ticket, the reveal of the playing card within the envelope and the destruction of the playing card.
